GENERAL WASTE COLLECTION REGULATIONS

RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY

The Municipality of Bethel Park provides weekly trash and garbage collection. Recycling takes place every other week on your regularly scheduled trash day. Republic Services is the Municipality's waste collection and recycling service provider. **If your home is missed or you have a concern about service, please call the local Republic Office at 412-429-2600 or email bethelparkpa@republicservices.com or contact The Municipality of Bethel Park at 412-831-6800, ext. 130.** Be sure you have followed the guidelines listed in this newsletter before calling.

Place all containers at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your pickup day or can be placed curbside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the day before to guarantee pickup. Empty containers must be removed from the curbside no later than 12:00 midnight on the day of collection. The contractor is not responsible to return for trash/recycling that has been set out late. Please separate trash and recycling, but not behind each other. The contractor is not responsible for the collection of any item outlined in this newsletter that is not properly prepared. Residents are responsible for clean-up of disturbed or scattered garbage/recycling.

Secure household garbage in containers up to 40 gallon that weigh no more than 50 lbs. Over-loading, loose garbage and bungee cords are a hazardous safety issue for the Republic personnel and will not be picked up. Do not place garbage in boxes.

Effective January 1, 2013, in accordance with the "[Covered Device Recycling Act](#)," Act 108 of 2010, which requires the recycling of certain electronic devices, fluorescent and CFL bulbs; **please be advised that these items will no longer be permitted to be set out curbside.** The ban applies to desktop and laptop computers, computer monitors, televisions and their peripherals. Residents will have the option of taking advantage of e-cycling programs offered by numerous retail stores and other recycling organizations that collect electronic devices and appliances.

Again, the ban applies only to desktop and laptop computers, computer monitors, televisions, and their peripherals. However, DEP urges you to do your part for the environment by recycling or reusing as many of your electronic devices as possible in order to limit the number of those items and their hazardous components from entering the environment through landfills and other disposal activities. ITEMS ACCEPTED WITH REGULAR TRASH COLLECTION FOR 2016

- **Carpets** should be tied and bundled in lengths not to exceed 48 inches & 18 inches in diameter so that one man can lift. Padding must be tack-free and protected from the weather (otherwise will not be collected).
- **Furniture, including mattresses and box springs, household goods and disassembled children's metal swing sets** will be accepted curbside.
- **Hot Water Heaters** will be collected when placed curbside.
- **Grass clippings** can be bagged and placed with your regular trash at curbside.
- **Yard Waste** – consists of leaves, garden residues, shrubbery and tree trimmings. Not to exceed 4 feet in length and 4 inches diameter-must be secured.
- **Empty paint and/or dried paint cans** may be placed at curbside. Paint can be air-dried or soaked up with newspaper or kitty litter. The contractor will not accept paint cans with lids on.
- **Toilets** will be collected curbside, however must separate the bowl and tank.

Garbage, rubbish not to exceed 15 bags or equivalent number of containers and/or no more than 2 bulk waste items can be placed at the curb each week.

RECYCLING AND LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

Recycling takes place every other week on your regularly scheduled trash day. Please refer to the 2016 Waste Collection Schedule to determine your recycling weeks. Glass, cans, and plastics may be co-mingled. Rinse out residue. Separate recycling from trash, but not behind each other.

MATERIALS TO BE RECYCLED

Metal: Aluminum, steel, tin & bi-metal cans, aluminum foil & foil products.

Plastic: Items numbered 1-7. (Examples: Baby wipe containers, household cleaning products, margarine tubs, shampoo bottles & beverage bottles.)

Glass: Clear, brown, & amber glass containers.

Paper: Paperboard boxes (such as those used for cereal, tissues and shoes), copier paper, magazines, newspaper, catalogs, junk mail including envelopes and telephone books. Corrugated cardboard must be flattened, bundled and no larger than 14 x 14 inches.

RECYCLING BINS

Recycling bins are the property of the Municipality for rental use and are to remain with the property when sold. Residents with newly constructed homes can obtain a complimentary set of recycling bins at the Municipal Building. Replacement bins are \$10.00 per bin.

Do NOT place items in plastic bags or boxes.

HOW TO HANDLE LEAF WASTE

Full bags of leaf waste will be picked up on the same day as regular weekly trash for curbside collection during the listed leaf weeks only.

2016 Leaf Recycling Weeks:  October 10 – 14 October 17 – 21 October 24 – 28
October 31 – November 4 November 7 – 11 November 14 – 18

- Six fall weeks of leaf collection are scheduled each year as indicated on the 2016 Municipal Waste Collection Schedule as shown above.
- There is no leaf recycling pickup Thanksgiving week.
- Leaves must be placed in paper bags or brown paper leaf bags available in local stores or in containers or boxes clearly marked "LEAVES" that can be easily dumped. **The use of plastic bags as a receptacle for leaves is prohibited and will not be collected.**
- Yard waste and grass clippings can also be placed at curb during leaf collection.

Residents have the option of 1) composting the leaves in their own back yard, 2) mulching leaves with a mulching lawn mower 3) bagging leaves & putting them out for pick-up during the leaf collection weeks scheduled. YARD WASTE - The third Saturday of each month April through September residents may place yard waste, leaves and grass clippings at the curb in paper yard waste bags.

2016 WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:

Observed holidays in 2016 are **New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, and Thanksgiving**. After a holiday falling on a Monday through Friday, pickup for the rest of the week will be one day later than the usual day, which is extended to include Saturday. **If a holiday falls on the weekend, there will be no delay in trash/recycling pickup.**

Below is the 2016 Waste Collection Schedule. Recycling is picked up every other week on your regular trash day. Check the table below to see if your street or townhouse complex is in **Week A** or **Week B** and then look at the calendar on the left to see which weeks you will receive recycling pickup.

COMMERCIAL, INSTITUTIONAL AND MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING REQUIREMENT NOTICE

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 150 (c) of the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act (Act 101), the Municipality of Bethel Park has adopted an Ordinance requiring all commercial and institutional establishments in the Municipality to implement recycling programs. All multi-family residences not covered under the Municipal waste contract are also required to implement a recycling program.

The Municipality's Ordinance requires that all commercial and institutional establishments and all multi-family residences not covered under the Municipal waste contract develop a system for recycling at a minimum the following items:

- High grade office paper
- Aluminum
- Corrugated paper
- Leaf waste

All establishments are required to submit the amount recycled in 2015 to the Municipality by January 31, 2016. A copy of an example reporting form may be found on the Municipality's web page - www.bethelpark.net.
