The Public Works and Maintenance Committee of Council met on Monday, May 23, 2022. The following items were discussed:

- 1. Grass Cutting RFP There was discussion about the need to outsource this task, but in the ended it was decided to move ahead with the award of the contract.
- 2. Bethel Church Road Traffic Study Council decided to move forward with Option 1 for \$10,900 from unassigned funds. The Council also requested that we contact the County to see if the lanes could be narrowed. This was added to the tasks for Trans Associates.

There was also discussion on Traffic Calming within Bethel Park – Council directed staff to investigate traffic calming devices on North Lightwood, Dashwood and Rocky Ridge. There was mention of Logan Road as well.

- 3. Orchard Drive to Orchard Avenue There was no discussion on this item
- 4. Baptist at Hamilton Intersection Improvements Council asked staff to reach out to Whitehall again to see if they would provide a match for the project. If they say no, remove any upgrades within Whitehall Borough and submit the grant for only work within Bethel Park.
- 5. Sherwood Drive Modeling Project Council requested to move forward with the proposal for \$30,000 from unassigned funds.
