- a. Drew Dowell Penn State Chestnut Tree Update.
  - Received 18 B3-level blight resistance chestnut tree seeds. Evey Hardware to donate buckets and potting materials to plant all the seeds. These need to grow for 2 years before being transplanted; these will remain at Public Works.
- b. Future projects for Shade Tree Commission
  - Bethel Park is eligible to apply for the Tree City USA Growth Award after one year of membership. This will be completed with the next Tree City USA Membership application.
  - ii. Friends of the Park Volunteer Program to be presented before Council. If passed, the program will start in Pine Tree Park.
  - iii. Idea proposal for Shade Tree Commission booth at BP Community Day; either educational booth or collaboration with Tree Pittsburgh.

- iv. Idea proposal for field trip to the Tree Pittsburgh facility.
- v. Idea proposal for future Tree Tenders to have a twice a year planting/pruning/mulching event to maintain park trees.
- vi. Idea proposal to transplant One Tree Per Child trees from NAMS to new site; to complete Spring 2024.
- vii. Idea proposal to join the Chestnut Foundation to support goal of restoring Chestnut trees to Bethel Park. Annual dues approximately \$300.
