Junior Hoops 1 & 2

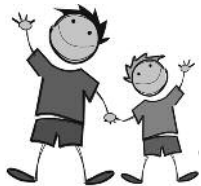

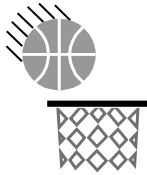

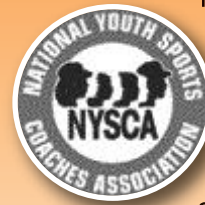
